The Tulsa Planning Office at INCOG is seeking an Urban Design Planner who is ambitious, hard-working, and creative to join our planning and design team. Our work helps guide future development and capital projects for the City of Tulsa with a focus on improving quality of life for all who spend time in Tulsa. This position is an excellent opportunity to use your talents to elevate the design and beautification of Tulsa's public realm. Join us on our way to becoming a world-class city.

Tulsa has something for everyone, from one of the largest collections of Art Deco architecture in the nation to thriving music, food, and arts scenes. Downtown is a hub for activity and events, with destinations such as the Woody Guthrie Center and Archive, which will have two new neighbors soon: the Bob Dylan Center and the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture (OKPOP). For outdoor enthusiasts, Tulsa boasts an extensive network of more than 100 miles of bike trails, a large urban wilderness area, nature preserves, and beautiful parks. The River Parks system winds along the Arkansas River from north to south, connecting neighborhoods and passing through the Gathering Place, a spectacular, half-billion-dollar waterfront park. Tulsa is also home to the Tulsa Drillers, a minor-league baseball team, and FC Tulsa, a USL soccer team, plus NCAA Division I athletics at the University of Tulsa and Oral Roberts University.

This position requires knowledge of physical design planning practices, including engineering and architecture, urban design, and graphic and modeling software. The successful candidate must have the ability to work collaboratively with a wide array of individuals from various backgrounds; complete planning and design assignments through analysis of complex technical and statistical information; formulate creative planning and design solutions; prepare planning documents and urban design graphics and understand and influence the behavior of others in order to achieve objectives and cause action or understanding.

Minimum qualifications include 3 years' experience in urban design, urban planning, architecture, landscape architecture, or a closely related field. A Bachelor's or Master's

degree in urban design, urban planning, architecture, landscape architecture, or related field is required. Annual salary range starting at \$51,875; specific compensation based on qualifications and experience. Comprehensive health and retirement benefits package included. A hybrid (remote work & in-office) work schedule may be available for this position.
