



Spatial Data Warehouse Coordinator

The GIS and Mapping Services Department is seeking qualified applicants for a Regional Spatial Data Warehouse Coordinator. The coordinator position will be primarily responsible for developing and maintaining the INCOG Spatial Data Warehouse focusing on enterprise GIS, GIS technical support, network monitoring and network backups.

The position requires knowledge of and experience with the ESRI ArcGIS Platform. Familiarity with VMware 6.7 (servers and storage), Microsoft SQL Server, ArcGIS Enterprise and Desktop applications are essential to the position. Applicants must also be proficient in Veeam network backup, Microsoft Windows, Excel, Word, and Outlook. Experience with monitoring software such as TreeSizePro, DuplicateFinder, PathLength Checker is desired.

Minimum qualifications: Bachelor's Degree in Geography or Computer Science; GISP certification is a plus. Experience with Enterprise GIS management, MS SQL Server Administrator and Python development is required. Other certifications such as Microsoft Certified System Engineer, Microsoft Certified Database Administrator ensures knowledge of networking concepts and design/implementation of SQL Server databases. Critical thinking and problem-solving abilities are highly recommended along with strong interpersonal skills to assist non-technical staff with complex technical issues.
