Andy Clarke, president of the League of American Bicyclists (LAB), will present a workshop developed by the Association of Pedestrian and Bicycle Professionals (APBP) for the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), as part of their program to implement the National Strategies for Advancing Bicycle Safety.

The workshop content is ideal for city engineers, public works directors, city planners, economic development directors, community development directors, mayors, city councilors, and Chamber of Commerce leaders.

As part of the program (depending on location), James Wagner, AICP, Transportation Projects Coordinator for INCOG, James Briggs, park planner with the City of Norman and Jan Ramseyer Fees, AICP, city planner with the City of Edmond will share their experiences on completing LAB's bicycle friendly application and lead a discussion regarding local issues.
