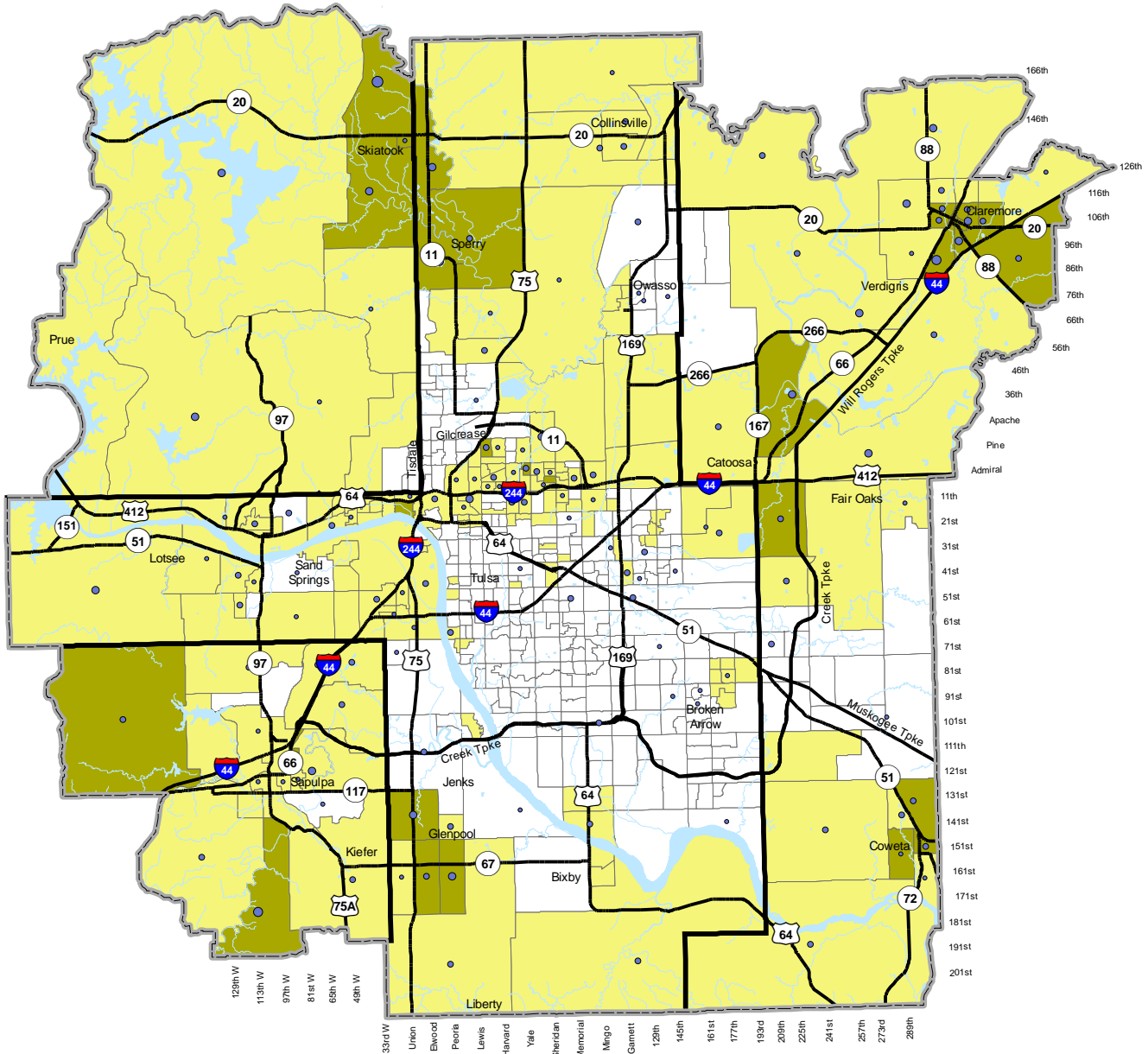


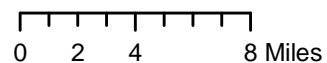
# American Indian Concentrations Within the Transportation Management Area

Standard Deviation is a comparison of the percent of American Indian population for that block group to the same percentage for the entire TMA. The higher the number the greater the concentration of the American Indian population.
